Interlocutor's Instructions

CHECK THAT THE RECORDER IS ON AND WORKING

Test time: 9 minutes

I = Interlocutor C = Candidate

PART 1 (2 minutes)

I: LanguageCert International ESOL, Speaking, Access level, (give today's date).

(Give candidate's full name.) Exam begins. Hello. My name's (give full name). Can you spell your family name for me, please?

- C: (Spells family name.)
- I: Thank you. Where are you from?
- C: (Responds.)
- I: Thank you. Now, Part One. I'm going to ask you some questions about yourself. (Choose **up to five** questions, one from each of the different topic areas, as time allows. Name the topic; eq 'Now, **Personal identification**'.)

Topics

Personal identification

- Where were you born?
- Which languages do you speak?
- How big is your family?
- Describe a member of your family.

Free time, entertainment

- Do you play any sports?
- What are your favourite television programmes?
- What kind of music do you like?
- What do you do in your free time?

Shopping

- Do you like shopping?
- How often do you go shopping?
- Do you think food is expensive here?
- Where do you usually buy your clothes?

(continued)

Food and drink

- What is your favourite food?
- What do you like to drink?
- Are you a good cook?
- How often do you go to a restaurant?

Daily life

- What time do you get up?
- What do you like about your English class?
- What job would you like to do?
- What did you do last weekend?
- C: (Responds.)
- I: (Interlocutor makes **brief** responses and/or comments.)
- I: Thank you.

PART 2 (2 minutes)

I: Now, Part Two. I'm going to read some situations. I want you to start or answer. First situation (choose one situation from A).

Α

- We're in the post office. I almost hit you with my bag. I start.
 Oh, I'm really sorry.
- I'm your friend. I start.
 Where shall we go at the weekend?
- You telephone the school to ask about your class. I start. *Hello, Central Language School*.
- I work in a doctor's surgery. You want to make an appointment. I start. Can I help you?
- C: (Responds.)
- 1: (Role-play the situation with candidate approximately two turns each.)
- I: Second situation (choose one situation from **B**).



- We're friends. Welcome me to your party. You start.
- We're friends. You're moving to a new home and you want some help. You start.
- I'm your teacher. You want me to speak more slowly. You start.
- I'm a shop assistant. You want to buy some presents. You start.
- C: (Initiates.)
- I: (Role-play situation with candidate approximately two turns each.)
- I: (Role-play a third situation from **A** or **B** if time allows.)
- I: Thank you.

PART 3 (2 minutes)


I: Now, Part Three. Here's a picture of a bedroom. (Hand over candidate's copy of the task.) I have a different picture of a bedroom. Let's ask and answer questions about the two pictures. I start.

PART 4 (3 minutes including follow-up questions)

I: In Part Four you are going to talk about something for one minute. You are going to talk about (choose topic for candidate).

Topics

- A Your home
- B School life
- C Staying healthy and well
- I: (Hand over piece of paper and pen/pencil.) You now have thirty seconds to write some notes to help you. You are going to talk about (repeat topic). (Withdraw eye contact for thirty seconds. Leave recorder running.)
- I: (Candidate's name), please start.
- C: (Talks.)
- I: (When candidate has talked for a maximum of one minute, say, 'Thank you', and then ask some follow-up questions.)

Follow-up questions

Your home

- Have you got your own bedroom?
- What do you like the most about where you live?
- What is your favourite room in the house?
- What can you see from your bedroom window?

School life

- What's the best thing about school?
- At what age did you start school?
- Do you have a favourite subject?
- Do you enjoy studying English? (Why?)

Staying healthy and well

- What exercise do you do?
- Do you like healthy food?
- How often do you eat fast food?
- Why is it important to eat vegetables every day?
- I: Thank you. (Give candidate's name.) That is the end of the exam.
